The objective of establishing the Resource Centre is to conduct **Free and Open Source Software (FOSS)** workshops on different courses like **Linux, Latex, Scilab, Python, PHPMySQL, Lotus**, etc. at various colleges and schools. Last year, more than 110 students of **our college successfully completed** Linux modules.
