Lastly, I would like to thank Head of Department, all faculty members and students for their everlasting support throughout the creation of this edition. Thank you. Stay Safe.





NEWS AT A GLANCE






The valedictory function of slot-II was held at the end of the Day 6. The function was graced by the presence of Prof. Vijay Vaidya, Secretary, ISTE.


CSI EVENTS






Objectives :
